



## **Food Allergy Policy**

The Far Hills Food Allergy Policy is as follows:

- We ask that everyone help us to maintain a safe peanut and tree nut environment by not bringing or sending foods containing tree nuts, peanuts, or their products and /or contaminants to school.
- Students in prekindergarten (PK) and Kindergarten (K) eat in their classrooms. Seating is designated by the teacher in the classroom as appropriate with regard to food allergies.
- No food containing peanuts or tree nuts may be prepared, served or eaten in the cafe. Students, faculty, and staff bringing lunch from home may not bring food containing peanuts or tree nuts.
- Peanuts, nuts and/or foods containing them or their products may not be brought to school for any reason including PK and K lunches, games, snacks, and decorations.
- Students in grades 1 through 4 with anaphylactic food allergies (requiring an Epi Pen) for foods other than peanuts and tree nuts must eat food brought from home. Students with food allergies can eat with their fellow students at regular tables in the cafe and will use a disposable paper placemat to keep their space free of potential allergens.
- Students in grades 5 through 8 are responsible for making appropriate food choices with regard to their allergies and may eat anywhere in the cafe.
